

Legislative Watch List 2024 Term

LB61 Introduced By: Brandt Committee: Transportation and Telecommunications

Topic: Authorize leasing of dark fiber and eliminate certain powers of the Public Service Commission

Potential Impact:

Would allow certain public entities to license dark fiber and amended regulations surrounding the purchase, lease, and license of such infrastructure.

Notes: Carryover, priority bill, advanced to E&IR Initial Floor Debate Date: 2/15/24

LB865 Introduced By: Bostelman Committee: Transportation and Telecommunications

Topic: Require annual reports to the Nebraska Broadband Office

Potential Impact:

On or before July 30, 2024, and by July 30 each year thereafter, each provider operating in this state shall submit a report to the Nebraska Broadband Office that provides specific information regarding each standard Internet service plan advertised by the provider and the rates associated with each such plan.

LB1031 Introduced By: Bostelman Committee: Transportation and Telecommunications

Topic: Change provisions relating to the Nebraska Telecommunications Universal Service Fund, dark fiber leases, and broadband telecommunications services.

Potential Impact:

Speeds must be capable of 100/20 Mbps to qualify for support from the Nebraska Universal Service Fund

Notes: Emergency declared, made priority bill Hearing Date: 1/22/24

LB1063 Introduced By: Halloran Committee: Education

Topic: Require approval by the voters of the school district prior to expenditure of special building funds as

prescribed

Potential Impact:

Requires a vote approval for improvements or the purchase of equipment for any existing school property to appear on any Special Election or General Election ballot.

LB1300 Introduced By: Bostar Committee: Government, Military and Veterans' Affairs

Topic: Adopt the Pacific Conflict Stress Test Act and the Foreign Adversary Contracting Prohibition Act

Potential Impact:

Outlines provisions and potential restrictions related to equipment or investments that might be at elevated risk from foreign adversaries.

LB1302 Introduced By: Lippincott Committee: Government, Military and Veterans' Affairs

Topic: Adopt the Cybersecurity Preparedness Act

Potential Impact:

Rewrite of LB651 from the 2023 term that reduced the fiscal note.

Notes: Emergency declared Hearing Date: 2/8/24

LB1336 Introduced By: DeKay Committee: Transportation and Telecommunications

Topic: Change provisions of the Nebraska Broadband Bridge Act and transfer certain powers and duties to the

Nebraska Broadband Office

Potential Impact:

Transfers certain responsibilities from the PSC to the Broadband Office

Notes: Emergency declared Hearing Date: 2/12/24

LB1389 Introduced By: Bostar Committee: Revenue

Topic: Provide for a personal property tax exemption for broadband equipment as prescribed

Potential Impact:

Allows the exemption of broadband equipment from personal property tax under specific circumstances

Notes: Hearing Date: 2/23/24

LB1417 Introduced By: Brewer Committee: Government, Military and Veterans' Affairs

Topic: Create, eliminate, terminate, and provide, change, eliminate, and transfer powers, duties, and membership of boards, commissions, committees, councils, task forces, panels, authorities, and departments and change and eliminate funds

Potential Impact:

Creation of Commission for K-12 Education/Elimination of the ESU CC. Elimination of the NTIC Tech Panel with duties passed on to the NITC. Elimination of the Rural Broadband Task Force.
