

State Government Council Priorities

The sector priorities of the State Government Council of the Nebraska Information Technology Commission are to provide recommendations that support:

- SGC-1** Implementing electronic government (e-government) to provide for a cost effective, efficient delivery of services while maintaining necessary security and confidentiality of non-public information;
- SGC-2** Improving collaboration, both between agencies and with other stakeholders, in all areas of IT;
- SGC-3** Providing a planning and implementation process for IT projects which avoids unnecessary delay and bureaucracy; and
- SGC-4** Supporting improved training, education, and change management.

The State Government Council Sector Priorities were approved at the June 29, 1999 NITC (Nebraska Information Technology Commission) meeting.
